# FUNDAMENTALS OF AURICULOTHERAPY (BASIC SEMINAR)

*With introduction to VAS (Vascular Signal of Nogier)*



**Public concerned:** The seminar addresses to all medical professions (medical doctors, dentists, midwives, veterinary doctors), as well as to all professions of health care interested in complementary medical techniques.

**Treated subjects:** The seminar will treat basic and fundamental knowledge in auriculotherapy. After a short reminder on the basics of auriculotherapy and ear point localisations, treatment protocols often encountered in daily medical practice will be presented.

**Requirements:** Existing knowledge in auriculotherapy is welcome but not compulsory. Those, who do not know auriculotherapy yet, can study the book "Auriculotherapy" (Raphaël Nogier, Thieme Editions or "Elements of Auriculotherapy" by René Bourdiol) to prepare for the seminar.

**Lecturer:** Raphaël Nogier (M.D.), is practitioner in auriculotherapy for more than thirty years. Author of numerous publications about auriculotherapy, he is teaching this discipline all over the world. He was president of the working group on the standardisation of the ear point nomenclature for the WHO. At present, doctor Raphaël Nogier is president of GLEM – Lyon Medical Studies Group, which assembles a large number of medical doctors working in the field of auriculotherapy. Being the son of Paul Nogier, who is the inventor of auriculotherapy, Raphaël Nogier worked close with his father for many years.


